2013 "Click It or Ticket" Campaign

You've heard the message: "Click It or Ticket" but are you buckling up? We hope so. May 10th marks the beginning of the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration's Highway Safety Office 2013 Click it or Ticket Campaign. The St. Mary's County Sheriff's Office along with Law Enforcement around Maryland and the nation are on the roads day and night enforcing our seat belt and child safety seat laws.

Motorist and passengers who are stopped for not wearing a seat belt will get a ticket. It's a simple fact – a seatbelt when worn properly, or a child properly restrained in a child safety seat increase the chances of surviving a serious crash but the equipment must be used night and day. It only takes a few seconds to "Click It" so buckle up, stay safe and avoid the ticket! Remember - Click It or Ticket-Day and Night.
