### **Bank of America Robbery Suspects Sought - Update**

On March 24, 2010 at approximately 0810 hours, the Bank of America, located at 21800 North Shangri-La Drive in Lexington Park was robbed at gunpoint by two black males. The suspects entered the bank, produced a handgun and verbally demanded money. The suspects then exited the bank with an undetermined amount of money. The suspects were observed exiting the area in a green Acura, which was recovered a short time later.

Information was developed the suspects then entered a dark colored sedan, unknown make or model and fled the area on Great Mills Road.

Suspect one is described as a black male, 20-30 years of age, approximately 5'11", 200 lbs., wearing a light in color hooded sweatshirt.

Suspect two is described as a black male, 20-30 years of age, approximately 5'5", 150 lbs., wearing green flight-style coveralls.
