Cameron would like to remind everyone there are still available openings for students to participate in Camp D.A.R.E. 2009, which will begin on July 27, 2009 and continue through July 31, 2009 at the Carver Recreation Center in Lexington Park. Camp D.A.R.E. will run from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm daily. Students entering the 5th and 6th grades in the 2009 - 2010 school years are eligible to participate. Camp D.A.R.E. is free.

Campers are taught Elementary School D.A.R.E. by certified D.A.R.E. instructors and at the end of the week each participant will receive a certificate of completion. Campers will also participate in numerous camping activities including arts and crafts, recreational competitions and public safety related demonstrations.

Camp D.A.R.E. is an excellent opportunity to meet new friends and learn important health, safety and decision making lessons. Lunch is provided daily for all participants. Parents must transport their children to and from camp each day.
