Crime Prevention and Traffic Safety Operations Results

On July 15, 2011 the St. Mary's County Sheriff's Office, in a continuing effort to reduce crime, improve driver safety and awareness and address quality of life issues such as loitering, drinking in public, vagrancy and panhandling conducted an operation in the Hollywood / Lexington Park area of the county. As a result deputies issued 23 traffic citations, conducted 38 traffic related vehicle stops, issued 9 written warnings, recovered 4 vehicle registration plates, towed 4 vehicles, arrested 1 driver for DUI and issued 5 alcohol related citations. Similar operations will be conducted in other areas of the county throughout the year.
