Great Mills Death Investigation

On February 19, 2013 at 3:30 A.M. police units responded to a residence in Great Mills, Maryland for the report of a suspicious person. Upon arrival police units encountered a man who was nude. The man advised he had been inside a residence visiting a woman when he was approached by a male subject and a struggle ensued. The man stated he had been assaulted by the male subject who had entered the residence. The man fled the residence. Police units checked the area of the residence where the struggle ensued and discovered a female lying in the rear yard of the residence deceased. BCI was notified and assumed the investigation.

Detectives are currently on the scene conducting the investigation. Multiple interviews are being done at this time and a person of interest has been taken into custody however no formal charges have been filed at this time. The deceased will be transported to the State Medical Examiners Office in Baltimore where an autopsy will be performed to determine the cause and manner of death. The names of the victims are not being released at this time.

The investigation is continuing. Additional information will be provided as it becomes available.
