Information Sought - Injured Subject

On July 13, 2011 at approximately 3:14 a.m. a man was found lying in the roadway at the intersection of Westbury Blvd and Pegg Road in Lexington Park, Maryland. The man sustained substantial injuries and was flown to local area trauma center. The St. Mary's County Bureau of Criminal Investigations is assisting the St. Mary's County Collision Reconstruction Team to determine the cause and circumstances surrounding the individual's injuries. The name of the man is not being released at this time.
