Sobriety Checkpoint Results

On November 30, 2012 the St. Mary's County Sheriff's Office conducted a Sobriety Checkpoint in the area of Three Notch Road and Charlotte Hall Road, Charlotte Hall, Maryland. Seven-hundred and six (706) vehicles passed through the two hour checkpoint. One operator was temporarily detained for suspicion of impaired driving, however; the operator performed satisfactory on the Standardize Field Sobriety Test and was released. In addition, seven other vehicles were stopped and issued various citations and warnings for violations ranging from minor traffic offenses up to suspended driver's licenses violations.
